

About Us...

We are a small family farm located six miles outside of Honesdale in the rolling hills of Wayne County, PA. Restoring the farmland has been our primary mission here at Anthill. The transformation from an old dairy farm into a diversified collage of sustainable fruit and vegetable production has proved to be both challenging and rewarding.

In addition to providing the most nutrient dense food possible, we have been working on a number of projects that will help us cultivate a more prosperous future for the communities we serve...

High Tunnels:

- * Two 30' X 96' unheated, plastic covered greenhouses for late fall, winter, and early spring vegetable production.
- * Reliable and uniform temperature and humidity protect plants and transplants from the cold and wind.

Root Cellar:

- * A 25' X 25' concrete cellar banked into the side of a hill provides a constant temperature for storage throughout the year.

Orchard:

- * Over 750 Hazel and Chestnut trees planted in the spring of 2008.
- * A collection of 150 European and Asian Pears planted in the spring of 2010 and 2011.

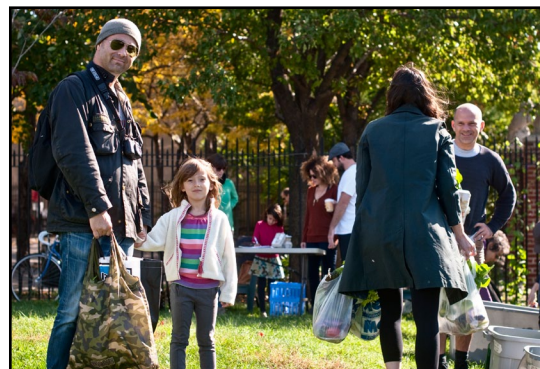
Forest Garden:

- * A perennial polyculture designed to be a self-sufficient garden based on woodland ecosystems.
- * Fruit and nut trees, berry bushes, shrubs, herbs, and vegetables grow on multiple levels in the same area.

Our goal is to help create alternatives to the dominant model of industrial agriculture, which we believe is wasteful, toxic, destroys rural communities and creates scarcity instead of abundance. We envision the Anthill Farm as at model for agriculture of the future: we draw on permaculture design principles, traditional farming practices and the latest scientific research in order to create a balanced agro-system that is sustainable, plentiful, and inclusive. Our fields, soil and produce reflect an emergent ethic about peoples' relationship to the earth and each other. We invite you to join us in this important experiment and to enjoy the delicious fruits of our labor!

CSA Information

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a food system where members pay up-front in exchange for a season's worth of vegetables. This relationship has many benefits: as a member, you receive fresh, pesticide and chemical-free produce directly from the farmer at below retail cost. In addition, you and your family can take the opportunity to come to the farm, spend time with us and get to know the other members of the CSA. As farmers, we enjoy benefits too! Because all of the funding comes to us prior to the season, we are able to pay for seeds, replace broken tools and gather any other resources needed to get our operation going.

Our CSA program spans twenty-two weeks starting the first week of June and runs until the end of October. Week-to-week, each share will include a mix of produce as it becomes available. We also send out an email newsletter called, "The Weekly Bundle", which lets you know what produce is in your share. Poetically written by Anthill's own, Monique, you'll get to enjoy recipes and little tidbits of information about the season, in addition to all of the upcoming events and volunteer opportunities happening at the farm.



As we continue to help our local food system grow in these tough economic times, it is of the utmost importance to us to make our produce available to people with a variety of financial situations. We've decided that a "Pay What You Can" sliding scale model puts us in the best position to serve the community. This system makes financial aid available for those who need it and gives others who support this mission the opportunity to donate, knowing that their extra dollars are helping a family who otherwise wouldn't be able to join.
